



## PTA Reflections Program Submission Information 2018-2019 “Heroes Around Me”

### Progression of Projects:

Projects in the program travel along the following path, stopping at all applicable levels in your area. Not all areas have all levels represented. For more information, contact the president at your local PTA.

- Local Unit (the PTA at your school)
- Council PTA (this level may not apply in all areas)
- District or Region PTA
- Illinois State PTA
- National PTA

### Local, Council, District, Region Submission Dates:

The deadline for Illinois State PTA is January 19, 2019.

***District and Region Directors can mail submissions or make arrangements to meet me halfway from your location to pass off submissions due to the late date of the January Board Meeting.***

All other local/council deadlines should be set to meet the State deadline. A good rule of thumb is to give at least two weeks to a month prior to the state deadline to allow time for the judging process.

- State Deadline – January 19, 2018 (when Districts & Regions submit their portfolios)
- District & Region Deadline – early to mid-December (for councils & local units to submit)
- Council Deadline – mid-November (for local units to submit to their Council)
- Local PTA Units – late October to mid-November (for students to submit to their local PTA)

### Entries to the State Level Judging:

The number of entries (per category – Dance, Film, Literature, Music, Photography, Special Artist, & Visual Arts) that can advance to the state level is determined by the paid membership dues as of May 15, 2018.
