

CHARTER RULES



- To carry on constructive work for better parenthood, better homes, better schools, and better communities.
- To refrain from all partisan and factional political activities.
- To refuse consideration by the association of personal grievances.
- To participate in the decision-making process establishing school policy, recognizing that the legal responsibilities to make decisions have been delegated by the people to boards of education.
- To cooperate with the superintendent, principal, and teachers in promoting the best interest of the school community.
- Acceptance of a charter binds an association to observance of these rules
