## 2023-24 National PTA Reflections Recognition for Illinois Students



We proudly announce 7 Illinois students chosen for national recognition in the 2023-24 PTA Reflections Art Program. This year, National PTA received over 900 national-level student submissions. Through two rounds of rigorous review by arts professionals at the national level, 223 students from 45 State PTA Congresses were selected for national-level recognition for their artwork.

The PTA Reflections Art Program annually recognizes elementary through high school students from around the country for 55 years. Every year, students are asked to use their artistic expression and initiative in Film Production, Dance Choreography, Literature, Music Composition, Photography, and Visual Arts to reshape the theme in their own way. This

year, students were asked to reflect on the theme "I am Hopeful Because..." Illinois PTA submitted 27 entries to National PTA to be judged with other national level submissions.
