2024-25 National PTA Reflections Recognition for Illinois Students



We proudly announce eight Illinois students chosen for additional recognition at the national level in the 2024-25 PTA Reflections Arts Program. This year, National PTA received over 850 national-level student submissions. Through two rounds of rigorous review by arts professionals at the national level, 223 students from 34 State PTA Congresses were selected for national-level recognition for their artwork. The PTA Reflections Art Program annually recognizes elementary through high school students from around the country for over 55 years. Every year, students are asked to use their artistic expression and initiative in Film Production, Dance Choreography, Literature, Music Composition, Photography, and Visual Arts to reshape the theme in their own way. year, students were asked to reflect on the theme "*Accepting Imperfection*." Illinois PTA submitted 27 entries to National PTA to be reviewed with other national level submissions.
